## GOVERNMENT INCENTIVES:

### 1 Emission Reductions for Alberta — Energy Savings for Business (ESB)

Any applications submitted after April 1, 2023 will be added to a wait list and reviewed in the order of receipt.

ESB will give businesses fast access to incentives for cost-effective efficiency measures:

- Up to **\$250,000** is available per project
- Up to **\$1 million** per parent company is available to cover the cost of products and services.
- Minimum incentive amount of **\$500**

**The deadline for project completion is 30 September 2023.**

**Incentives are available for equipment upgrades and installations that include:**

### 2 Incentives for Zero-emission Vehicles by Government of Canada

The Incentives for Zero-Emission Vehicles (iZEV) Program is continuing until March 31, 2025, the incentive is maximum of \$5,000 depending of the vehicle specifications.

The iZEV Program offers point-of-sale incentives for consumers (subject to funding availability) who buy or lease a ZEV vehicle. Only the vehicles listed in the website are eligible for an incentive when they're purchased or leased for at least 12 months, on or after the eligibility date.

**There are two levels of incentives:**

- Battery-electric, hydrogen fuel cell, and longer-range plug-in hybrid vehicles are eligible for up to \$5,000;
  - longer range plug-in vehicles have an electric range equal to or greater than 50 km.
- Shorter range plug-in hybrid electric vehicles are eligible for up to \$2,500;
  - shorter range plug-in vehicles have an electric range under 50 km.
